## MINUTES.

MT. CARMEL BAPTIST CHURCH,  
 JAMISON, S. C., October 18, 1889.

The Orangeburg Baptist Association was called to order by the Moderator at 10 o'clock, Friday morning, October 18, 1889, in the meeting house of the Mt. Carmel Baptist Church. Hymn, "Jesus, lover of my soul," was sung. The Moderator read the first Psalm, and prayer was offered by Bro. H. L. Baggott.
